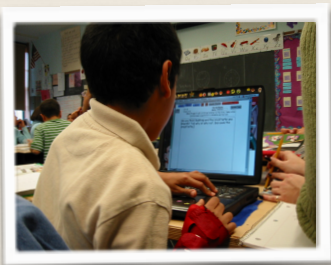

Our new service, "**AT Train**", provides **Free Assistive Technology Seminars** for educators, therapists, and advocates (parents and professionals) who serve the needs of individuals with disabilities. Trainings usually encompass any or all of these **three types of sessions**:



Assessment: Determining participation challenges for individuals w/ communication, physical access, learning, sensory, or attention/behavioral needs.

Acquisition: Exploring a variety of Assistive Technology options available to address the particular needs of the people they serve, and how they might be obtained.

Implementation: Training in the operation and integration of Assistive Technologies based on peer-reviewed research and best practices.

AT Train has been graciously funded by the **J.E. & Z.B. Butler Foundation**, and the hands-on technologies have been funded by a grant from the **Flutie Foundation**.

Mark Surabian has utilized assistive technologies to directly serve the needs of thousands of individuals with disabilities for over 30 years. 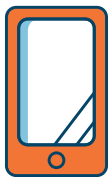
